SAM CLUB FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

4. WHO WILL SUPPLY SUN SAFETY EDUCATIONAL INFORMATION, SUNSCREEN AND OTHER SUN SAFETY ITEMS FOR THE SAM CLUB ACTIVITIES?

The RDK Melanoma Foundation will supply any educational material and sun safety items needed for activities. However, you will need to inform the RDK Melanoma Foundation representative at least 1 month before the activity is scheduled to occur. The RDK Melanoma Foundation will only be able to provide what we have available.

5. WHAT KIND OF SUN SAFETY ACTIVITIES CAN THE SAM CLUB PLAN?

The SAM Club can plan any sun safety activity that the school's administration will allow. The RDK Melanoma Foundation would like for all SAM Clubs to plan an activity for Melanoma Monday (first Monday in the month of May). This is the national day of skin cancer awareness. The SAM Clubs should also schedule other activities during the month of May for Skin Cancer Awareness Month. These activities should be focused on the education of skin cancer. **IMPORTANT**—For any activities scheduled for Melanoma Monday, please give the RDK Melanoma Foundation's representative at least 2-3 months advance notice if you would like a representative from the Foundation to be present.

6. CAN THE DERMAVIEW MACHINE BE USED AT SAM CLUB ACTIVITIES?

Yes! **ONLY IF YOUR SCHOOL IS LOCATED IN PALM BEACH COUNTY, FL**
The DermaView machine is a machine with a "black" light that shows how much sun damage you have accumulated on your face, neck and ears (the more sun damage you have the more chances you have of getting skin cancer.) In order to have the DermaView machine at an event, the President or Sponsoring Teacher will need to give the RDK Melanoma Foundation representative advance notice to see if the machine will be available. A RDK Melanoma Foundation representative will need to be present while the DermaView machine is being used.
