Be creative! Imagine that the sign you create will be shrunk down and placed on the front of this great sunscreen dispenser. This will tell your friends and faculty what they need to know regarding sun safety out on the field at school. People will walk up to the machine, place their hand underneath, and plop...a little bit of sunscreen comes out for them to use on their skin. Any media is acceptable on paper that is 11x14 (horizontal) or greater. Include some or all the 'SunSmart Rules', and design something that gets attention and action!

- Use sunscreen and lip balm with SPF 30-50+. Reapply sunscreen every two hours.
- Wear a wide-brimmed hat, sunglasses, and sun protection clothing when possible.
- Sit under an umbrella or in the shade.
- Avoid the sun during the peak hours of 10am-4pm, when rays are strongest.
- Never use a tanning bed!
