He presented the proclamation to Sanjana Deshmukh and her students from Art World Academy (Casselberry, FL).



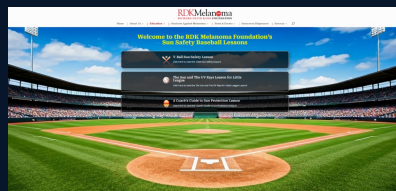
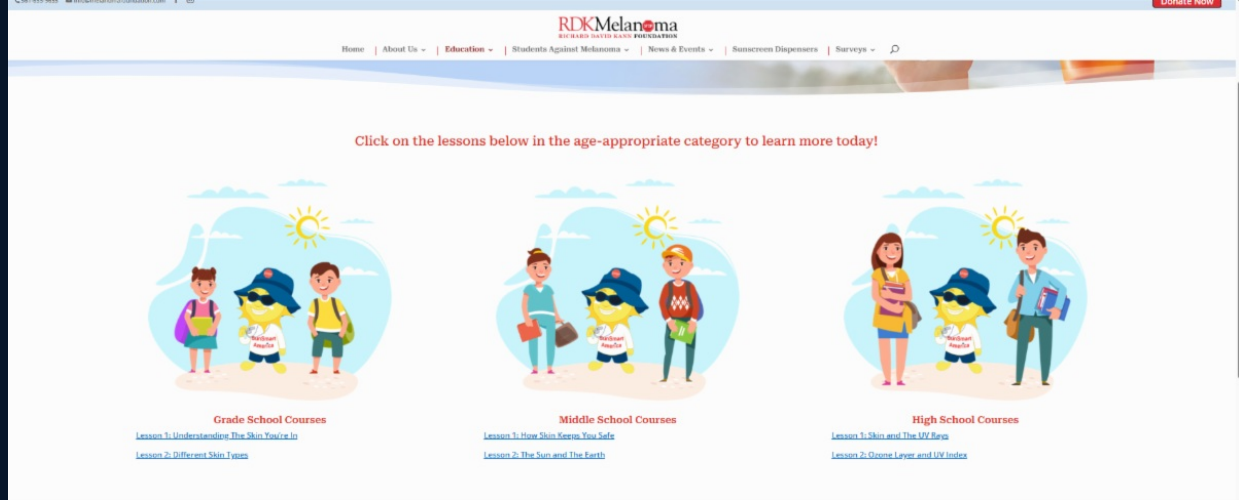
