DESCRIPTION:

- Participate in e-mails to discuss the latest education updates regarding the SunSmart America™ Curriculum

DIRECTIONS: (in the order to be administered)

- Teachers will give their students a Pre-Test located at the beginning of each Topic
- Complete five SunSmart America Lessons & Student Activities (1 Student Lesson & 1 Student Activity from each of the 5 Topics)
- Teachers will give their students a Post-Test located at the end of each Topic
- Teachers will submit the Pre & Post Test to Eric Stern and/or RDK Melanoma Foundation
- Teacher will submit student activities to Eric Stern and/or RDK Melanoma Foundation
- Teachers will complete and submit the Teacher's Survey to Eric Stern and/or the RDK Melanoma Foundation
- Once the requirements are submitted the teacher will receive Professional Development Credits from the Palm Beach County School District and incentives provided by the RDK Melanoma Foundation
